CHILD SUPPORT SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

1. At least one parent must be a member of the North Carolina Child Support Council or a client of the Child Support Program (through either Child Support services or Clerk of Court services).
2. Applicant must be a resident of North Carolina and a graduating high school senior.
3. Applicant must have been accepted by a North Carolina school of higher learning: a College, University, Community College or Technical School. **Applicant needs to attach a copy of the acceptance letter.**
4. Applicant must have maintained an overall C average or above during his/her high school career.

The scholarship will be awarded by semester – 50% at the beginning of the first semester and 50% at the beginning of the second semester. **Recipient must send proof of enrollment at the beginning of each semester to the Treasurer of NCCSC: Gwen Neely, 2201 Darden Place, Wilson, NC 27896. The money will be sent directly to the school you are attending. Should the recipient fail to return to school the second semester or fail to request the second semester payment by January 31, 2013, the second semester money will be forfeited.**
7. **Application must be postmarked no later than April 16, 2012.** Final decisions will be made no later than April 30, 2012. The recipients will be recognized at the NC Child Support Conference in August 2012.
